




Aid for Trade to the LLDCs PRIORITIES




Aid for Trade Disbursements to LLDCs Volume, Sector Distribution and Growth

USD bn. 2015 Constant







Top 10 Aid for Infrastructure Recipients

(volume - per capita 2011 -15)






Aid for Trade Commitments to the LLDCs




Aid for Trade Disbursement to LLDCs grants and loans









