

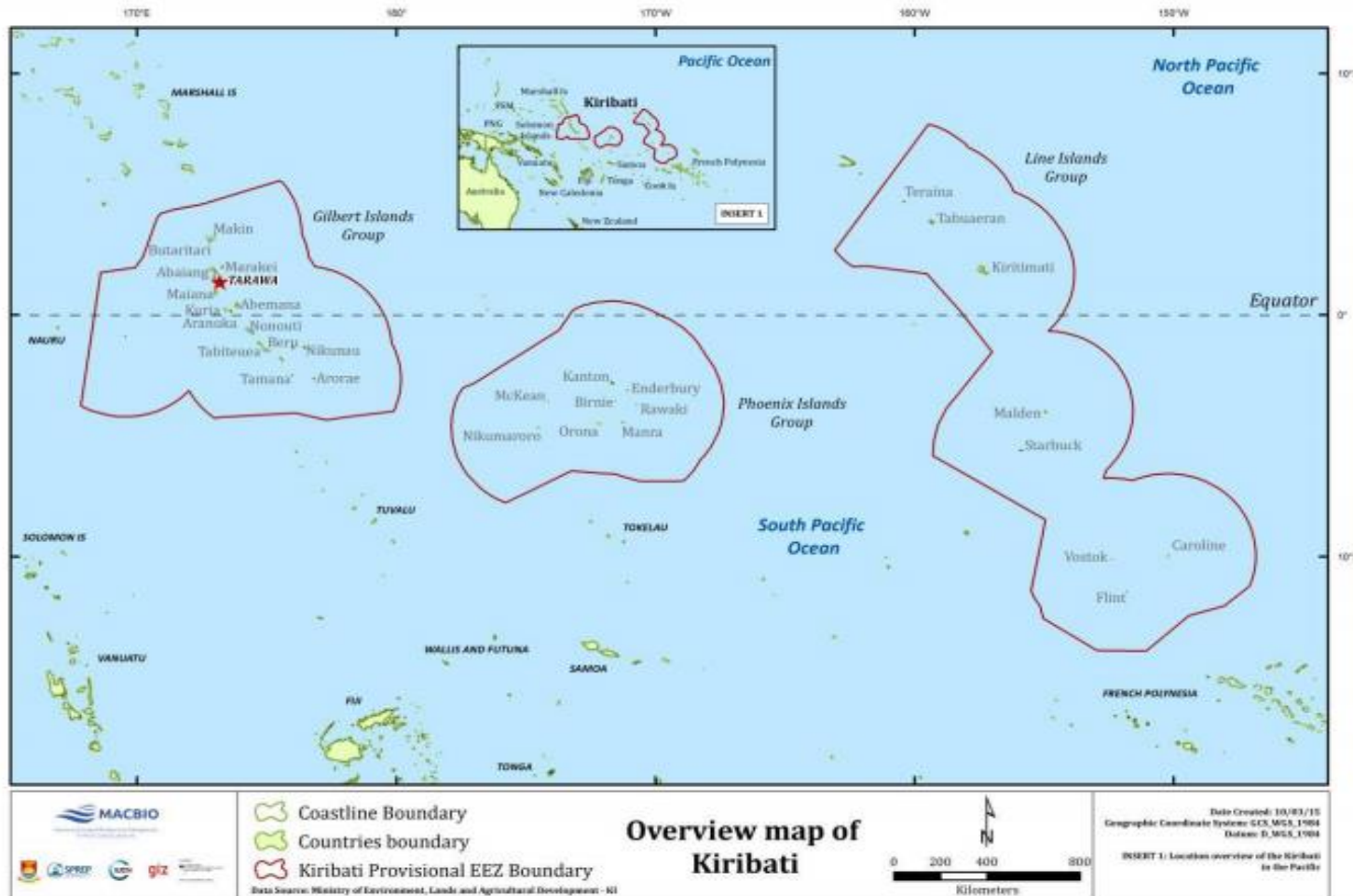

KIRIBATI BACKGROUND



- Three main island Groups dispersed over 3.5million square kilometres containing 33 scattered atoll islands
- Population of 103,058 of whom 50.7% of female and 49.3% male
- Main Source of Revenue: Fishing License

The Kiribati Experience

1. During the review of the KDP, KV20 and SDG Indicators, this highlights several areas of indicator fragmentation and poor data collection.
2. Additional resources were mobilized to complement existing support from UN and PIF, but clearly it shows that data issues and fragmentation continue to be persistent challenges.
3. At the Global, regional and even at the national level, indicators are currently beyond the capability of Kiribati to effectively measure and report on.

Key Challenges

- Low monitoring and evaluation capacity
- Poor capacity to collect and analyse data
- Inadequate financial, technical and human resources
- Financial Constraints
- Relevance of Indicators and Targets

Way Forward

1. Strengthening the statistical/data capacity of NSO Staff
2. Mobilizing financial and technical resources
3. Centralization of data information
4. Data mining
5. To enhance capacity for collection and analysis of data
